### **Results in the Board Exam – 2022**

The results of Class X Board Exams for the session 2021 – 2022 was 100%. 153 students had appeared the Exam, out of which 36 students secured above 90% marks with the highest percentage of marks being 98.40%.

The results of the Class XII Board Examination for the session 2021 – 2022 was satisfactory. 160 students appeared the exam out of which 5 students secured above 90% marks with the highest percentage of marks being 94.8% in Science and 90% in Commerce.
